

We are currently recruiting for our **Residence Assistant Designate** pool.

In the event Student Housing Services has a vacancy for a Residence Assistant (RA) position, we look to offer that job to an individual from our RAD pool. Residence Assistant Designates (RADs) participate in RA Training, and live in residence throughout the academic year. Vacancies may come up throughout the summer months, or at any time during the academic year. ***RADs are required to live in residence.***

Applications close on Wednesday June 9, 2021 at 12:00 pm Eastern Time.

What do you receive as an RAD?

- You will be given a priority status where we look to secure one of your top preferences for accommodation in residence as an RAD.
- You receive engaging skill building training in a variety of areas that will help building your transferable skills and resume. This training is tentatively scheduled to take place August 18th-September 2nd, 2021.
- Housing and Meals are provided during August training, and a \$150.00 (amount currently under review) honorarium for training.
- As a member of the RAD team, your experience is added to your University of Guelph Co-Curricular Transcript.
- We will offer you the opportunity for paid employment as a member of the Duty Staff team and when other opportunities arise where extra staff are required (extra Guest Table staff, fire watch etc..). ***In order to be eligible to take on these additional roles you will need to obtain up to date Criminal Reference Check and First Aid/CPR.***

This is not a paid opportunity, however RADs receive a stipend, and housing/meal costs covered for participation in August Training. If moved into an RA position, individuals would receive RA compensation.
